## **Other Fees not necessarily Big Fix associated**

Veterinary Examination with appointment	\$25.00
Emergency Examination (did not make an appointment, urgent care needed)	\$60.00

All other services for emergency/sick pet care will require patron to have the animal surrendered to the shelter and pay either the adoption fee, or a minimum of 25% of the cost of services performed- whichever is greater. Cost of care is not to exceed \$500.00 unless the owner is willing to pay for the difference. All animals treated will be required to be sterilized, current on vaccines, and microchipped to receive care. If the animal will require more extensive treatment/ lifelong management, the shelter will not be able to provide care but can offer humane euthanasia.

## **Patrons will be eligible to re-adopt if they meet the following criteria:**

- Have not received food assistance in the last 6 months
- Have not been convicted of animal cruelty
- Have not received CAS-assisted veterinary services within the last 12 months prior

Typical Costs associated with common emergencies	
Pyometra (uterine infection)- requires OHE	\$500-\$700.00
Limb Fracture-- amputation	\$300-\$700.00
Parvovirus treatment	\$100-\$500.00
